

India : From my square lens – Part 1



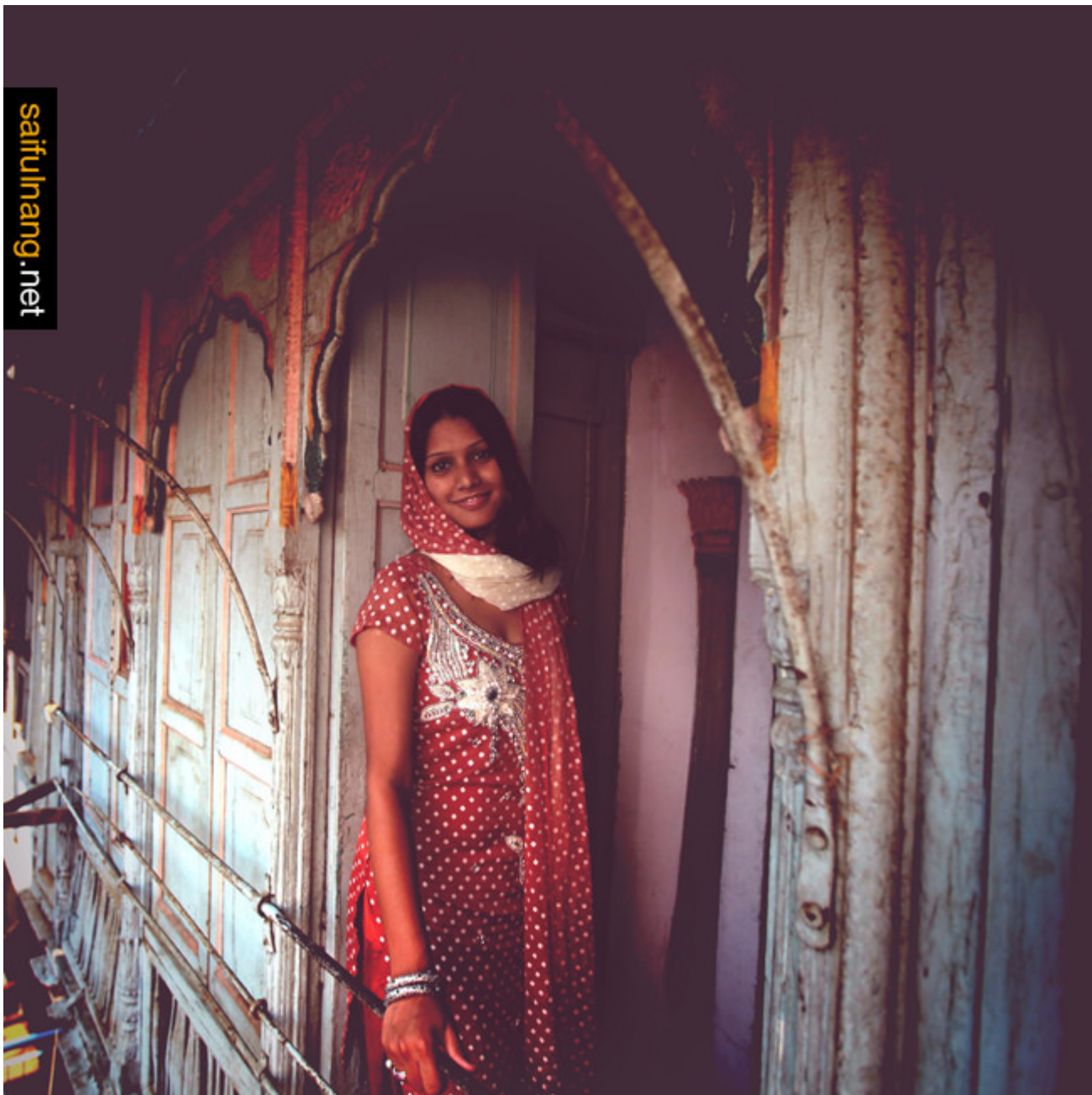
